**Colour Code** Colours are red tops and black pants, shorts or skirts

Alternatively if items are purchased from retail stores they must be the correct colours. Checked dresses for girls are acceptable.

**Hats** are required during Terms 1 and 4. Hats provide protection from the sun and as such should be in good repair. Appropriate styles include bucket and broad-brimmed hats.

**Jewellery** is discouraged; however items of religious significance are allowable. Any jewellery that is worn must not present a safety hazard. Chains and necklaces should be worn inside clothing where they are protected. Earrings must be small studs or sleepers.

**Please be aware** make up, nail polish, denim, clothing with incorrect colours, with brand names, slogans or logos are not acceptable.

**Health and Safety** Footwear should meet safety standards and allow students to be involved in physical activity during the day. Items which are not acceptable include thongs, clogs, slip-ons, ballet flats and heeled shoes.

To help prevent the spread of head lice, hair shoulder length or longer must be tied back with bands in school colours.
