

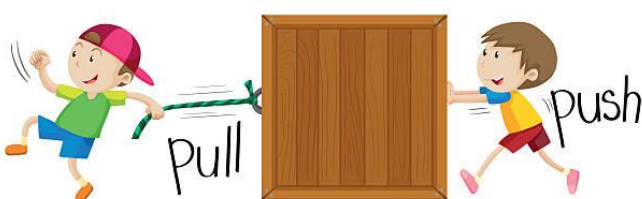
English

- Continuation of guided reading groups, based on current reading levels.
- Students will continue the whole school program of Words Their Way. This is a word study program, which supports deep learning of words being learnt and studied.
- Handwriting – unjoined upper and lower case letters.
- Students will be taught descriptive writing, focusing on the structure, purpose and developing descriptive language. This will incorporate our geography unit of place.
- Continuation of recount writing developing and extending students' experiences and shared experiences.
- Continuation of learning tricky words.

Science

Physical Sciences – Push and Pull

This term students will investigate how a push or a pull affects how an object moves or changes shape. Focusing on learning about different pushes and pulls and how students can identify these within different contexts such as forces on land and water, toys and motion, machines and sinking and floating.

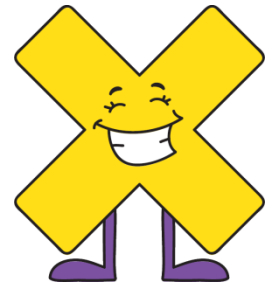


Maths

Number and Algebra

In Maths this term we will be continuing to focus on Number and Place value.

- Recognise and represent multiplication as repeated addition, groups and arrays.



Money and financial mathematics



- Count and order small collections of Australian coins and notes according to their value.

- Investigate the effect of one-step slides and flips with and without digital technologies.

Ms Angela's Term 3 Classroom Overview

Italian – Mr Rob Cherin

Throughout term 3 students will explore the Italian language through children's songs, poems and traditional stories which will promote active listening, translating, speaking and responding. Students will continue building on the language foundations gained in Terms 1 and 2.

Geography

This term the students will be looking at 'Defining Places' in Geography Humanities and Social Science (HASS) Australian Curriculum.



Unit 1 - Inquiry Defining Places: What is place?

Students will develop their understanding of the location of the major geographical divisions of the world in relation to Australia and the definition of places as parts of the Earth's surface that have been given meaning by people, and how places can be defined at a variety of scales.

Physical Education – Mr Daniel Nguyen

This term Year 2 students will develop how to move safely with their bodies through exploring different body positions. They will demonstrate a basic understanding in Gymnastics. Students will also develop ball control, kicking techniques and rules related to the game of Soccer.

Health and Wellbeing (Social and Emotional Learning)

This term students will continue to participate in the mandated Keeping Safe: Child protection Curriculum. Students will be concentrating on the focus area of Recognising & Reporting abuse. Students will describe physical and social changes that occur as children grow older and discuss how family and community acknowledge these. Students will also practise strategies they can use when they feel uncomfortable, unsafe or need help with a task, problem or situation.



Technology

In STEM this term students will learn the design process and create a playground which will incorporate maths and our science unit Push and Pull where students will apply their knowledge of forces and shape.
