

Term 1, End of Week 3 Roundup

We are so pleased to have all students back at school doing their learning. It is lovely to see classrooms buzzing, quite a change from the empty rooms of online / remote learning for the first couple of weeks.

Students may arrive at school from 8:30am when yard supervision begins. If you require supervision before this time, please make arrangements with OSHC.

We would like to thank all parents who are dropping off their children on Surrey Road for respecting the speed restrictions, abiding by the 2 minute drop of zone and in particular stopping at the crossing allowing children to cross safely. This is supporting our community in ensuring all children arrive safely to school.

We are in the process of starting our intervention programs. Two SSOs have been trained in a literacy intervention program (MiniLit Sage) and another will be trained in Macqlit. Screening processes are underway to identify students requiring literacy support. SSOs have started working in classes to support numeracy, with each class having access to two lessons per week. Teachers use a range of strategies and differentiate the learning, SSOs support the teachers to provide learning opportunities for the students and their individual needs.
