Changes to Inclusive Education Support Program

The Department for Education is implementing new funding arrangements to provide schools with more autonomy and flexibility to support children and students with disability at your school. The changes have been informed by the feedback we've received through consultation with staff, associations and schools, and a commitment of the government in the lead up to the election.

The new arrangements give more funding certainty to schools so that they can continue to make adjustments for our students with disability to engage in their education at school (called the Supplementary Level Funding grant). The process for accessing funding for students with disability who require more frequent and intensive support has not changed. These reforms are just one of many initiatives aimed at improving support for children and young people with disability.

Schools will continue to undertake personalised learning to ensure children and students have the support they need to succeed in their learning.

The new Supplementary Level Funding grant will be introduced from term 1, 2024.
